Our Learning

Nursery and Reception

Welcome to the new children who have started in Nursery over the last few weeks. They are making new friends and having lots of fun. The children are just finishing off their 'Sunshine and

Sunflower' topic before we move on to their new topic 'Big Wide World'.

Acorns (KS1)

The Year 1s completed their phonics screening check last week and were true superstars. In class we are continuing our topic on school days with a focus on Victorians this term. This week we are completing a DT project involving learning how to slice, chop and mash fruit and veg. We will be making our own salads and trying them in class.

Oaks (KS2)

Oaks have completed their persuasive writing on the Roman Emperors and are moving onto biographies. In DT they have made greenhouses using knowledge of 'properties of shape' to help them. During the trip today they will have had the opportunity to experience Saxon life and make links to our science topic on classification by learning about the different native species at Escot.
