Our Learning

Nursery/Reception:

We have been busy with our 'build it' topic making our own towers with a variety of bricks and blocks. Our story of the week last week was The Three Little Pigs and we made mud brick houses to see if the big bad wolf could blow them down. This week our story is 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' we will be making our own bridges for the troll to hide under.

Acorns (Years 1-2):

We have enjoyed our first session of swimming last week, and all the adults were impressed by how much progress we have made since our swimming in the autumn term. As part of our topic 'Bright Lights, Big City', and our literacy, we followed instructions to make our own bread rolls and butter. See Facebook for photos. In maths, we continue to learn about time.

Lower Oaks (Years 3-4)

Lower Oaks have excelled in the play this term and along with Upper Oaks have produced an amazing performance.

In Maths, we have been looking at decimals and money. Children often do not get to work with actual money these days and so it would be good if there are any opportunities to give them a chance to purchase things and work out the exact money or the change that they should expect. In Literacy, they have just started a new book called 'Here Comes Hercules' by Stella Tarakson – which they will be reading, and then writing their own adventure story involving Greek Historical figures.

Upper Oaks (Years 5-6):

A huge congratulations to Upper Oaks for their phenomenal performance in their play. When not rehearsing they have been focusing on 2D shapes and angles and they have been writing a formal letter to Mr Johnson regarding homework!

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
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
