## Our Learning

### **Nursery/Reception:**

We've been continuing our topic "Build It" by designing our own houses and using different shapes to draw pictures of them. We've also been building dens with blankets, pillows and tents and talking about all different buildings. We have also had the Lego bricks to build towers and castles for the toy figures.

### **Acorns (Years 1-2):**

In Maths, we are learning about money. We have learnt about the value of each coin and note, adding amounts together, and will continue with problem solving and finding change. We have enjoyed using our senses in science to identify different items.

In Literacy, we are going to finish the term by writing poems for East Worlington Fete in August.

### **Lower Oaks (Years 3-4)**

Lower Oaks have worked really hard on completing their assessments last week and preparing work for our celebration of learning. I am incredibly proud of the superb outcomes from this year with every child reaching or exceeding targets that have been set. Lower Oaks have been an absolute pleasure to teach and their superb attitude to learning and their learning behaviour has made this a really fun year of teaching.

### **Upper Oaks (Years 5-6):**

In English, we have been looking closely at playscripts and their different features. We have also been writing our own playscripts about the Leopard's Drum. This has really helped us when rehearsing for the Leopard's drum production.

In Maths, we have been looking at position and directions. We have been learning about coordinates and translating and reflecting shapes. Year 5 have also completed some maths assessments.

### **OOSC - Out of School Club with Angie Lunn**

The children in OOSC have been using the wooden planks, boxes and crates to make their perfect dens. During the warm weather, the

children filled up the paddling pools and they all went for a dip!

During arts and crafts we built boats to sail in the paddling pool.

You open an online Tax-Free Childcare account and the Government adds 50p for every 80p you pay in. You then pay your childcare provider from that account.

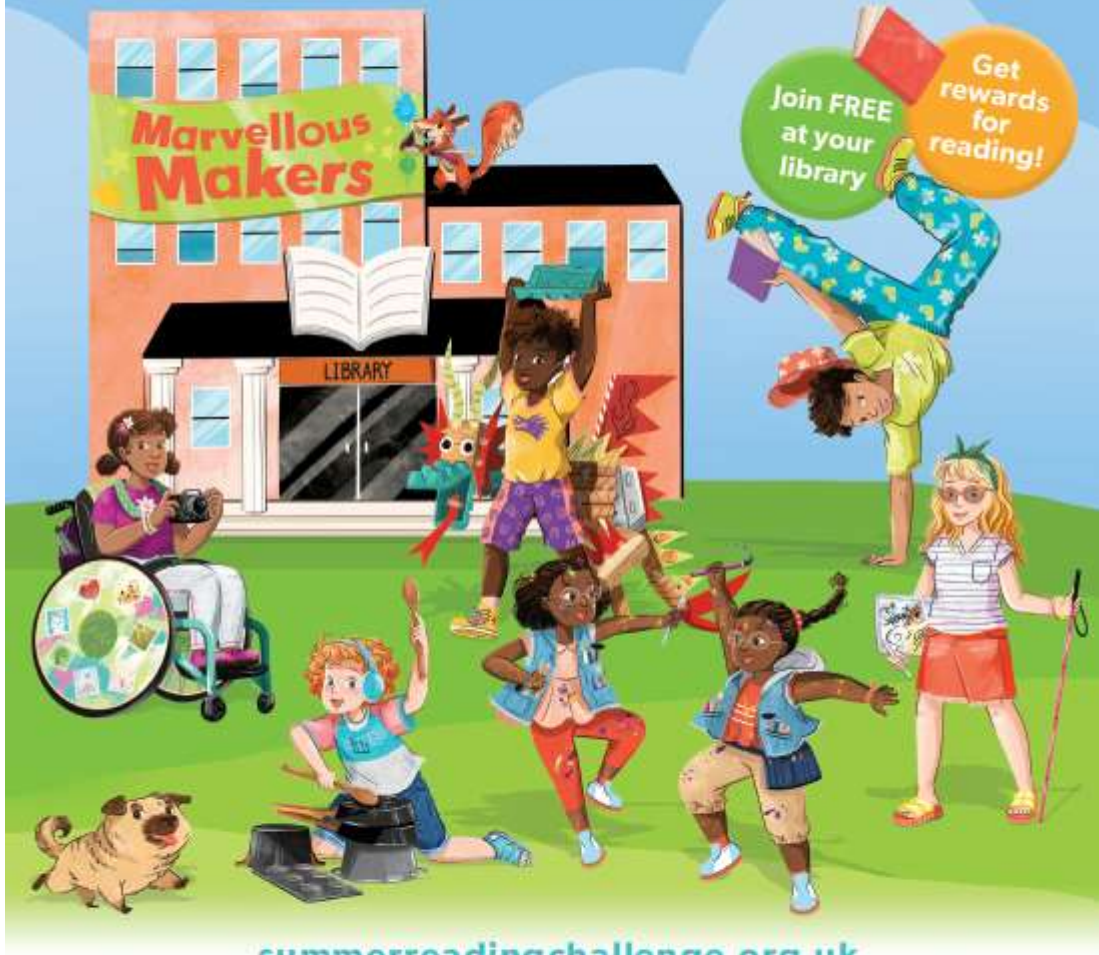
