### Open Afternoon

We would like to invite parents to an open afternoon on the 21st of January.

Parents of children in the nursery and our toddler group are invited to stay and play with the children between 1 and 2:30pm.

Parents of Oaks and Acorns are invited to come and join their children for activities in class followed by maths workshops. Parents are invited to attend the classes from 2:00 with a KS1 workshop at 2:00-2:45 and KS2 2:45-3:30.

### Healthy Eating

As a school we would like to continue to encourage children to make the right choices about their nutrition and drinking. We are taking part in the tooth cleaning project with our younger pupils, but we would like to ensure that all children have the right drinks during the day. Staying hydrated is essential for so many things, however even sugar free drinks have small amounts of sugar in them. Our teeth are designed to withstand up to 4 acid attacks per day, so a sugary drink or fruit drink during meals is a perfectly acceptable choice, however we would request that all water bottles that the children have in class only have water in them.

Our younger children are provided with a fruit snack to keep them going during the morning so please can Oaks bring in fresh fruit for snack. This means no dried fruits or cereal bars at all. We understand that children need this snack to give them a boost to last until lunch, so please feel free to provide more than one piece of fruit if needed.

Please can we encourage parents who provide packed lunches to be more mindful about the packed lunch content. Processed foods are not a healthy alternative to fresh products and while these are a great time saver, in most cases they contain significantly higher levels of chemicals, salts and sugars than unpackaged alternatives. As with school dinners where the rest of the lunch is balanced a treat or sugary pudding is a great way to encourage children to eat the rest of their packed lunch.
