Science Fayre – Friday 4th April

We will be capping off the science focus for this term with a science fayre. There will be 2 categories for each year group family and independent. The fayre will be in the afternoon of the 4th of April at 1:30pm. Children will be encouraged to enter a science experiment or a model demonstrating a science concept. In addition, children need to make a poster to show the science behind their experiment and be able to talk about it. Children who are entering the independent category need to do 95% of the planning and work. Family entries can be done collaboratively with parents, but the children need to contribute at least 50% of the work and be confident to talk about the science.

The event will be held down in the hall and Dr Hilary Anderson will come and speak to the children about their work. She has a long history of working with children and the children will be supported by their class teachers. We would like to invite parents to come in to see the experiments on display at 3pm, and to join us for an end of term celebration assembly and prize giving.


