**OUR LEARNING**

**Early Worlies/Nursery**

In Early Worlies last week we were focusing on Mother's Day, we talked about why we love our mummies so much and what they help us do. We made beautiful cards and bags as a special present for our mums.

This week we are focusing on Easter crafts and fun, don't forget to join us tomorrow with your child for our Easter Egg hunt.

As spring is in full swing, please pack your child's bag with something warm for the early mornings and hats and suncream for the afternoon sun. (Please apply suncream before your child comes in and we will top them up at lunchtime ready for outside fun in the sun.

**Acorns**

We have been busy growing our sunflowers and beans this half of the term. We have all been reading and writing non-fiction texts about the life cycles of various plants and animals.

In Maths, Year 2 have looked at multiplication and division.

**Lower Oaks**

Lower Oaks have completed their text on 'The Iron Man' and written stories in the style of the author. We have moved onto a rainforest guide book which is a book about conservation and we will be writing our own class guidebook on the Arctic.

In Maths, we have been learning about equivalent fractions, mixed and improper fractions.

**Science Fayre – THIS FRIDAY!**

We will be capping off the science focus for this term with a science fayre. The fayre will be in the afternoon of the 4th of April at 1:30pm. Children will be encouraged to enter a science experiment or a model demonstrating a science concept. In addition, children need to make a poster to show the science behind their experiment and be able to talk about it. Children who are entering the independent category need to do 95% of the planning and work. Family entries can be done collaboratively with parents, but the children need to contribute at least 50% of the work and be confident to talk about the science.

The event will be held down in the hall and Dr Hilary Anderson will come and speak to the children about their work. She has a long history of working with children and the children will be supported by their class teachers. **We would like to invite parents to come in to see the experiments on display at 3pm, and to join us for an end of term celebration assembly and prize giving.** The age of the child will be taken into account when judging. There will be prizes for the two family project entries and prizes depending on the age of the child.

#### Breakfast Club for Reception to Year 6

The free Breakfast club for compulsory school age children only (those in Reception to Year 6 inclusive) starts after Easter and is available to book now! **Please note that this has to be booked in advance and cannot be booked on the day and you have to arrive between 8:25 and 8:35am. Children who do not arrive by then will need to then wait until 8:50am when the school gates officially open.** Parents who normally use the OOSC will see a reduction in cost to reflect the free half hour breakfast club ie OOSC is usually £4 per hour and parents can now book 8-9am club for £2 instead.

Unfortunately the timing of this means that the CAT bus will be too late to book but the DCC minibus with Reg does arrive in time. Please can we ask that all those parents book and inform the Breakfast Club Supervisor (Mrs Ford) of any dietary requirements.

Please see the screenshot below. You can book Breakfast Club in the same place as School Dinners and OOSC. In your child's individual "account" and please skip the week until you arrive at Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> April.


**Changes of circumstances**
