Our learning

Nursery/Early Worlies

This week in Early Worlies we will be talking some more about how we grow from babies into children, teenagers and then adults and talking about who is in our family.

Later on in the week we will then be looking at how a caterpillar changes into a butterfly and the differences we can see. We are continuing to listen to musical storyline after lunch, phonics and write dance this week.

Acorns – Reception, Years 1 and 2

We have enjoyed the start of this term exploring our theme of the beach. Over the rest of this half term, we are going to look closely at a few sea creatures and finish sewing our own sea creature toys. Reception and Y1 are enjoying their English text 'The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch' and the Y2's have just started a Fiction unit about 'Mrs Armitage and the Big Wave'.

In Maths, we are beginning a unit on Fraction. Reception Maths is focussed on length and time.

Lower Oaks – Years 3 & 4

Over the next two weeks we will be starting a text called "Fantastically Great Women who changed the world" eg Amelia Earhart, Mary Seacole and Rosa Parks.

In Maths, we will be looking at time.

Please note that homework is Mathletics and spellings.

Upper Oaks – Years 5 & 6

In Maths, we have been learning about algebra and how symbols can be used to represent different numbers. We have also been recapping skills from across the year in preparation for the Year 6 SATs.

In English we have been looking at a text called Flood by Alvaro F. Villa. The text is made up of fantastic illustrations and has no words. We have been focusing on how to develop atmosphere in our writing as well as using dialogue.

This week the Year 6s will of course be doing their SATs!
