Nursery/Early Worlies

Theme of the Week: Goldilocks and the Three Bears

This week has been full of storytelling, exploring, and lots of noisy bear sounds as we dived into the classic tale Goldilocks and the Three Bears!

The children have loved discovering the different versions of the story and spotting what's the same and what's changed. We've been focusing on fantastic describing words such as roar, growl, and squeak, and the children have enjoyed trying out each sound as they pretended to be the three bears (or sometimes even Goldilocks!).

Our room was transformed into a mini story world as the children re-enacted the tale using different-sized chairs, bowls of porridge, and cosy beds. It has been wonderful watching them make connections between the story and the props, using language from the book in their play.

Meanwhile, our youngest learners have been busy exploring porridge oats scooping, pouring, and transferring them into different containers. This sensory play has supported their fine motor skills while helping them engage with the story in their own way.

It's been a warm and wonderful week of storytelling, imagination, and hands on fun. We can't wait to see what adventures next week brings! 🌈📖🌟



Acorns - Reception, Year 1 & 2

Reception

Reception have been busy sharing, learning and completing different activities based on various Traditional Tales as part of their topic 'Once Upon a Time'. In maths, they are learning to match the correct number of objects to the correct digit.

KS1 - Years 1 and 2

In English, we have learnt to retell the story of 'It's my Birthday' and will be writing our own stories over the next week. In maths, we are learning about addition and will move onto subtraction over the next few weeks.

All of Acorns enjoyed their visit from Steve and Abi this week. We were very impressed by the bandaging skills of the children and they all loved going to see inside the ambulance.



Lower Oaks

Lower oaks have written amazing stories based on the Monster Slayer. Please do come in and share the story with your child.

In Maths, we have been focusing on the 2 x, 4 x and now 5 x tables in our Mastering Number Sessions. In a teaching sequence we are learning to use column addition and subtraction.

We are now moving onto a teaching sequence on How Santa Works.

Upper Oaks:

Maths: we are just finishing our unit on multiplication and division focusing on factors and multiples. We will then be starting our fractions unit.

English: year 6's have just finished their SATs baseline assessment. During this time, the year 5's have been writing a story about the dragon slayer. We have just started looking at a Dr Ernest Drake's Dragonology. This unusual book looks at different dragons in depth. We are going to be learning all about dragons and then use this information to create our own dragons.

All of the children should have come home with this leaflet and we hope you have managed to view your child's artwork!


