Nursery and Reception

This term's topic is called "Sunshine and Sunflowers". We will be planting seeds and watching them grow, and seeing what happens when white flowers are placed in food dye.

Acorns (KS1)

Oaks (KS2)

Oaks have started their topic on "Emperors and Empires". They are looking at Roman life and the progress of the Roman Empire.

Please can we ask that all children remember their swimming kit, packed lunch and water bottle every Wednesday (except Wednesday 11th!).



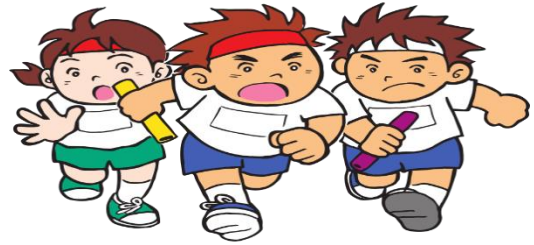
